European Law Amendment Government Law changes

Changeover to Lead-Free products for 2011

On 1 August 2008 the European Union Commission decided on Lead-Free Bearings and Bushings in the Motor, transmission and compressors for Air Conditioning.

This Government requirement takes effect on 01 July 2011.





In order to make sure the changeover to leadfree alloys meets the 1st July 2011 deadline, it is advised to begin the changeover process as early as possible to validate lead-free alloys:

product development

product process and product approval

material test (engine test stand/endurance test)

change of production process

release and implementation

It is possible that unforeseen time and effort could be required during the changeover to lead-free alloys due to the complexities of implementation.
